### ABOUT BLACKBURN & DARWEN YOUTH ZONE

Blackburn & Darwen Youth Zone, opened in May 2012 as an independent Charity, but we are proud to be part of the growing OnSide Network.

We work with young people aged 5–19 (up to 25 with additional needs) and offer youth work, health and wellbeing and employability services, giving young people somewhere to go, something to do and someone to talk to. Whilst our building and activities provide a hook for young people to initially engage with us, the relationships they develop with our team of Youth Workers ensures they return night after night. We pride ourselves as being one of the leading youth organisations in Blackburn and Darwen.

Our service to young people is focussed around a state-of-the-art, multi million pound facility that is purpose-built and remains dedicated to young people. This facility has recently undergone a 3 million pound transformation thanks to the Youth Investment Fund. This funding has allowed us to redevelop our Blackburn site to be able to offer a wider range of services for young people whilst celebrating the history of the building. Our newly developed Fusebox is the site where electricity was first generated in Blackburn. Alongside our history we also have a football pitch on our roof, this is one of Blackburn's best kept secrets!

Our services for young people are needed more than ever and despite the prevalent challenges around the lasting impact of the pandemic, young people feeling isolated and the cost of living crisis, our team continues to provide a home from home for young people.

#### THE ROLE

Reporting to the Facilities Manager, primarily based at Blackburn Youth Zone, you will be responsible for maintaining cleanliness and hygiene, ensuring that all areas are well presented and safe for use. This role requires attention to detail and a commitment to delivering high quality cleaning services.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- To perform a range of cleaning activities including cleaning toilets, sanitary fittings and surrounds; spot cleaning of spillages; wiping furniture, ledges, pipes, paintwork, doors and polishing door glass; emptying and cleaning bins; mopping and spraycleaning hard floor surfaces; floor polishing; wiping, polishing and straightening furniture; replenishing supplies in toilets; and moving items of furniture and equipment.
- To operate cleaning machinery for cleaning soft and hard surfaces, such as vacuum cleaners and polishers.
- To follow opening and closing procedures for the Youth Zone, as directed by the Facilities Officer or another appropriate manager.
- To report immediately any emergency maintenance problems, including toilets and other water fixtures, or hazards to the Facilities Officer or another appropriate manager.
- Follow health and safety regulations whilst using cleaning products and equipment.
- To comply with all other policies and procedures, with particular reference to safeguarding, codes of conduct and equality and diversity, to ensure all activities are safe, accessible and inclusive.
- To be an active member of the team, carrying out any other reasonable duties as requested by the management team, and operating in line with the values and principles of the Youth Zone.



### **MEASURABLE OUTPUTS:**

- Blackburn site fully clean and ready for use by workers, volunteers and young people by the end of shift (normally 11am)
- Cleanliness satisfaction rating > 8 out of 10, scored by Facilities Manager, Workers and Young People on ad hoc basis.

### **WORKING HOURS**

This role is required for 8 hours across a Saturday and Sunday morning 4 hours per day.

There may be occasions when working in evenings and weekends are required due to Youth Zone operating hours.
