BYZ has seen some amazing developments over the past few months as we have strengthened our position as the hub for the community at the heart of the town. Collaborations with organisations such as One Voice, Scouts, Girl Guides and local sports clubs have helped to increase our reach and number of young people benefiting from our offer and world class facility. This year has seen over 29,000 young people benefiting from our offer to date in projects and activities designed to increase integration, health and wellbeing and raise skills and aspirations. Projects delivered include STEM with BAE and UCLan, Commando Joes KS1, KS2 and KS3 Character education programme, Young Leaders group, science projects and we have introduced our Digital Design programme including coding, animation, digital art, robotics, fashion and gaming.



a runway for their planes, developing further engineering knowledge and skills. Young people are extremely grateful for the opportunity to participate.

Blackburn Youth Zone runs a holiday club every half term for 8 - 11 years. This half term has been a fun-filled STEM & Construction themed Holiday Club. Holiday Club is just £10 a day or £40 for the week with breakfast, lunch and snacks provided.

Blackburn Youth Zone awarded National Lottery support

Blackburn Youth Zone has received a National Lottery Heritage Fund grant of £29,200 for a 12-month project exploring Blackburn's rich history of influential women. Made possible by money raised by National Lottery players, the Strong Sisters project will engage members of Blackburn Youth Zone's Girls Group in researching the strong and rich heritage of women from Blackburn with Darwen

and further afield with the aim of inspiring them to follow their own dreams and ambitions.

They will look at how women have played key roles in events throughout history such as the Suffragette movement, establishment of the Lancashire Women's Centre and women in Parliament, including Blackburn's own Barbara Castle who was until recently, the longest-serving female MP between 1945 and 1979.

The project, which will run throughout 2019, will see also see

young people visit the People's History Museum in Manchester and the Houses of Parliament in London.

The girls will deliver various exhibitions throughout the project both at Blackburn Youth Zone and Blackburn Museum, which will be open to the general public.



The F Factor: looking to find the entrepreneurs of the future workshop

Founders of the Future is coming to Blackburn Youth Zone to run a workshop for budding entrepreneurs aged between 14 to 25! At the end of the workshop the young people will have all the information they will need to enter The F Factor – an exciting start-up competition for pupils and young adults, now in its fifth year.

The workshop will give you an

understanding of the type of ideas that the F Factor would like to see submitted to the competition, and how to bring these ideas to life.

The F Factor gives young people a chance to win £10,000 equity-free cash and to pitch in front of the most successful tech entrepreneurs in Europe, during Founders Forum.
